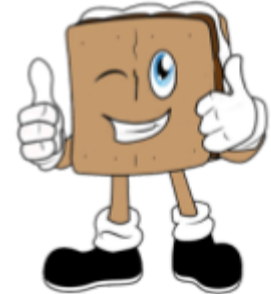

## **BECOME A TECHNOLOGY INNOVATOR WITH LEGO MINDSTORM ROBOTS**

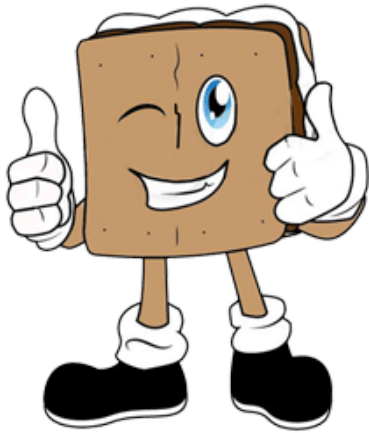

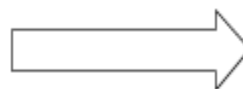
